"Compline" is derived from the Latin term from Catechetical Lecture after Presanctified Liturgy which we get the word "complete"; the compline service marks the end, or completion, of a calendar day. The Greek term is apodeipnon, which means "after supper". In other words, these are prayers said before retiring Zoom ID for sleep. "Small" Compline is part of the daily cycle of services throughout the year. During the Great Fast, we Lent, Lunch, and Learn 880-334-8094 begin to use the "Great" Compline, which is characterized by its greater length and multitude of psalm Thursdays, Noon // Virtual and in Person readings and hymns. Each evening of the first week of the Fast, different sections of the Great Canon of St. Andrew of Crete are chanted in Great Compline as well. It is "Presanctified" because the Holy Gifts 6PM Catechetical Lecture following Vespers (bread and wine) were sanctified at the previous Sunday's Divine Liturgy and saved for later. This is because the centuries-long practice of the Church is to not permit the celebration of the Divine Liturgy on weekdays during the Fast (with the exception of the Feast of the Annunciation). The Presanctified service is preceded by Palm Sunday Presentation the Ninth Hour, consists of the first part of Vespers, and the parts of the Divine Liturgy that follow the April 28 at 5PM Christ's Final Hours consecration of the Holy Gifts.
